Types of Data Backups

Full Backup

- Saves everything on your system in one place
- Fast and simple to restore.
- Requires more storage, making it a pricier option.



Incremental Backup

- Only saves changes made since the last backup.
- Great for regular, frequent backups.
- Slower to restore as multiple backups must be accessed.



Differential Backup

- Saves all changes made since the last full backup.
- Restores faster than incremental backups.
- Takes longer to back up and can be more complex to
